

Summer Camp Procedures – 2019

July 8- 26, 2019

These are the rules/procedures for summer camp. Please sign and return to St. Pius by June 8, 2018.

- Only students registered for St. Pius School may attend summer camp.
- **Balance of payment is due June 7, 2019.** Cost is \$185 per camper. If payment is not received by June 3rd, your child will not be permitted to attend summer camp.
- Aftercare is \$50 a week. Payment is made through TADS.
- Drop-off is from 8:50-9:00 am. Early drop-off (Before care) is from 8:00 – 8:50. Cost of early drop-off is \$25 a week. Payment is made through TADS.
- If not attending aftercare, pickup is between 3:00-3:15pm. \$10 will be charged for the first fifteen minutes late, from 3:15-3:30. Each additional 5 minutes will cost \$5.
- Aftercare pickup is at 5pm. Late charges apply as follows: \$10 will be charged for the first fifteen minutes late, from 5:00-5:15. Each additional 5 minutes will cost \$5.
- Each camper must bring a drink, water bottle, snack and lunch each day.
- Campers must wear socks and sneakers each day, no sandals or open toed shoes.
- Campers must remain on premises throughout entire day. No student will be permitted to leave school without being accompanied by a parent/guardian.
- If someone other than a parent/guardian is picking up camper, a note must be given to camp director. Children will only be released to parent/guardian unless otherwise notified.
- In case of emergency, children will be kept inside locked school. The number to reach the director before camp is 301-262-0203. Summer camp number during summer camp will be 240-472-2639.
- Children must respect peers and adults at all times. St. Pius behavior is expected at all times.
- **Cancellation fee \$50 per week.**

St. Pius is providing a summer camp program that includes music, drama, PE, computers, cooking, arts and crafts and more. We promise to provide adult supervision at all times. However, St. Pius, its staff, administration and summer camp director assume no responsibility for any injury that may occur. *Director of summer camp reserves the right to ask a camper to leave for behavior or any other extenuating circumstances. If a child is asked to leave, no refunds will be given.
