NEW 7TH AND 8TH GRADE STUDENTS AND ALL 6TH GRADE STUDENTS ORIENTATION - AUGUST 22

All 6th grade students and new students in 7th and 8th grade are required to attend the orientation on Thursday, August 22nd from 10:30am to 12noon. Students will have an opportunity to meet the middle school teachers, go over the routines, locate classrooms, and get answers to those "first day in a new school questions". Dress is casual.

NEW PARENT ORIENTATION - AUGUST 22

New parent orientation for those families with new students in grades 1 through 8, will be on Thursday August 22nd at 7:00pm in Nelson Hall. This special orientation is for parents only and students may not attend.

REQUIRED SUMMER READING AND MATH

To keep students engaged in learning and flexing their "mental muscles", St. Pius X has required reading and math assignments for students to complete over the summer. Work is to be completed between June 12 and August 23rd. Please be advised any IXL Math work that is done before June 12th will be erased. Summer work was sent home with report cards in June and is posted on the website. New students were emailed IXL user names and passwords. **Summer IXL Math work will be counted as a test grade.**

SAFETY FIRST

Traffic during arrival and dismissal is very heavy during the first few days of school. We ask that parents try and carpool if possible. We have a team of teachers and staff who direct and manage traffic to keep our students safe and it is imperative for the parents to follow their directions. Please familiarize yourselves with our procedures and traffic diagrams, which can be found on pages 27-30 in our Parent Student Handbook (found online at stpiusbowie.org under the Parents Tab). We thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation to help our arrival and dismissal system run smoothly. **For those children walking to and from school, there will no longer be a crossing guard to cross the children in the morning or afternoon. Mrs. Schrom will cross the students in the afternoon, but it will be the parents' responsibility to cross students in the morning.**

WALKER'S PASSES will be required for those students who walk home (or to caregivers). Students who do not live in a surrounding neighborhood will not be issued a Walker's Pass and are expected to be picked up and dropped off on school property (NOTE: you may NOT park your car in a surrounding street and have your child meet you there). These rules apply to everyone and are enforced to keep children safe. [Walker Pass Applications](#) will be sent home the first day of school and will be required on September 30th.

LUNCH TIME

St. Pius X Regional School has partnered with Main & Market so parents may order and pay for student lunches online.

Main & Market provides a healthy portion controlled lunch every day. Each lunch costs \$5.50 and you have the option of ordering an extra entrée for just an additional \$1.75. The

monthly menu provides a wide variety to choose from so that students are able to

experience different foods, with an emphasis on fresh, seasonal, and local foods. If you are interested in ordering from Main & Market, you will need to register online at <http://mainandmarket.boonli.com/login> with our school password of CAVALIER22. Lunch order deliveries will begin on September 3th for those who have ordered by August 25th. More details are available on our website. If you have

questions, you should call Main & Market at 410-626-0388 or email them at lunchprogram@mainandmarket.com. Milk order forms will be sent home at the informal Open house on Thursday, August 22nd. The first day of milk service will be Thursday, August 29th for students in grades 1-8. K students will have milk service starting Friday, August 30th. PK students will have milk service starting Tuesday, September 3rd. Information about special lunches such as Chick-fil-A day and Pizza day will be sent home soon. Special lunch days will start in October and updates will be posted in this column.



LATE PICK-UP POLICY: Families whose children are not picked-up from school by 3:30pm on a regular dismissal day will be charged a fee of \$1.00 per minute per child for each minute beyond 3:30. Families whose children are not picked-up from school by 12:30pm on an early dismissal day will be sent to ESP and charged a fee of \$35 (The fee for an early dismissal drop-in. This policy will go into effect on Monday, September 9th).

LATE DROP OFF POLICY: UPDATED If a child arrives late more than 2 times per quarter, they will not be allowed to be considered for perfect attendance.

WEB BASED ONLINE GRADEBOOK FOR PARENTS AND STUDENTS



Rediker Plus Portal gives you secure access to your child's grades, scores, attendance, discipline record and homework. Parents can also access school announcements, alerts and the school calendar. This platform will create a strong connection between school and family by sharing information that is critical to students' success and learning. Access to the Parent and Student Portals will be opened on August 22nd. New families will receive an email with instructions.
