

Dear Incoming 3rd Grade Families,

In an effort to keep students focused on math during the summer months, we are assigning some IXL practice for review for our incoming 3rd graders. Regular math practice during June, July, and August can help children avoiding learning loss over the summer and be ready to continue building skills in 3rd grade. Students will log into IXL using the same login information they have used throughout the school year.

Parents - please monitor your child as he/she completes the lessons we have assigned below **from June 11th-August 26th. Please do NOT have the students start their IXL work until June 11th. If they start before June 11th, their work WILL BE ERASED.**

We expect students to work to achieve a minimum SmartScore of 80 on each individual lesson. Once your child completes the required **2nd grade sections** , he/she is encouraged to work beyond those sections for further practice!
