\*\*\*One (1) **At-Large seat**—This seat has traditionally been held by a non-Catholic parent, although all interested school parents/guardians may apply.



Update: We received more than one application for the at-large seat and are currently interviewing at-large seat candidates. An update will be posted in News Notes once a selection has been made.

If selected for an upcoming vacancy, successful candidates may be asked to attend regular board meetings this spring. Please note that several of the seats require the applicant to be an active member of that parish. The at-large seat may be filled by either a Catholic OR non-Catholic school parent/guardian. If multiple parents/guardians apply for one seat, the Board reserves the right to schedule interviews of potential qualified candidates.

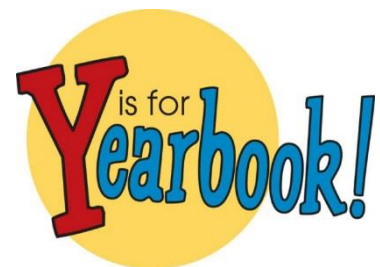

- 1st Grade - Canned proteins (tuna, salmon, chicken, peanut butter)
- 2nd Grade - Pasta and sauces (pasta, spaghetti sauce, macaroni and cheese)
- 3rd Grade - Canned vegetables (low sodium mixed, green beans, corn, tomatoes)
- 4th Grade - Soups (beef stew, chili, chicken noodle, turkey, rice)
- 5th Grade - Whole Grain Cereal (Cheerios, Cornflakes, Raisin Bran, plain oatmeal)

# UNFULFILLED VSP HOURS WILL BE BILLED



Parents are encouraged to check their VSP balances to make sure their 20- hour commitment (10-hour commitment for single parent household) will be fulfilled by the end of the school year. **You will be charged \$25 per hour for each hour that is unfulfilled, so don't get caught short.** Every hour you serve must be logged on our online volunteer hour tracking system called, Track It Forward. **Every** SPX school family should have a Track-it-Forward account including room parents, CYO coaches, H.S.A. committee chairs and board members. If you have not started your VSP hours, here is the process to get started. **Every volunteer must register online using this website:** <http://www.trackitforward.com/site/st-pius-x-regional-school?type=register>. After creating an account, volunteers will login and hours will then be submitted online, stating the date, hours, activity, and chairperson. Please be sure to include your name when logging your volunteer hours. Volunteer hours will then be approved electronically by the chairperson.

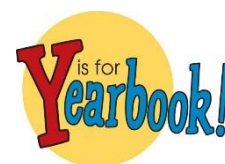
