

## Reopening Plan for 21-22 school year

St. Pius X Regional School will be completely in person beginning Aug. 31, 2021. Teachers and staff will work from the building from 7:30-3:30 daily beginning Aug. 23, 2021.

### Health and Safety of the Staff:

1. Teachers will be asked to use one of 2 bathrooms during the day. Our day porter will clean the bathrooms throughout the day and make sure there are soap and towels.
2. Face masks will be worn by faculty and staff.
3. Teachers will be able to meet in small groups to keep a check on each other and be a support for each other.
4. Desks will be placed 3ft apart as directed by the CDC.
5. Positive Covid results will be reported to the parents if they occur. Procedures will be sent to parents as needed.
6. Nurse Benson will monitor the students that report any illnesses and parents will be advised per the Maryland Department of Health Guidelines.
7. Nurse Benson will conduct class lessons on proper handwashing and mask wearing.

### Catholic Identity:

Our entire faculty and staff will attend the virtual Opening School Mass. If they are comfortable, they will attend with the whole faculty in Nelson Hall where social distancing is possible. If not, they can attend from their classroom.

1. We will begin our day with daily prayer over the loudspeaker. Each class will begin with a prayer.
2. Religion classes will be taught every day according to the student schedule.
3. Outreach programs will continue monthly.
4. In person Masses for students are in the discussion process.

#### Academics:

1. Professional development will be held for teachers in the month of August to assist with the complete reopening of our school.
2. Students and teachers will follow their regular daily academic schedules. All subjects will be taught daily.
3. Teachers will prioritize standards for this school year. They will also use End of Year 20-21 covered standards form to help adjust what standards need to be retaught before they begin with 21-22 standards.
4. Weekly lesson plans will be developed by each teacher to be reviewed by administration weekly.
5. Daily attendance will be taken and submitted to the school office.
6. Teachers will return to the established grading policy that was used prior to Covid. Teachers will use Plus Portals to post grades.
7. The student support center will continue to work with students that have accommodation plans. CAP and Accommodation plans have been updated and signed. The plans will be presented to the new teachers in August.
8. Monthly faculty meetings will take place on the scheduled half days. PD will be set according to what the faculty needs are at that time.
9. Scantron testing is set for Aug/Sept.
10. Back to School nights are planned for in person during the month of September.

#### Marketing and Communications:

1. Parents will be surveyed throughout the year to gather information about interests, concerns, and preferences.
2. A letter will be emailed to all parents, faculty, and pastors about the reopening plan.
3. Our website will be updated giving most current information.
4. Weekly news notes will go out to each family and be posted to our website.
5. Teachers will post daily/weekly classroom updates on their class pages.

6. HSA/SB will reach out to all new parents during the first weeks of September.
7. Administration Coffees will be held with the administration and parents.
8. Back to School nights will be held.
9. 8<sup>th</sup> grade high school night will be held.
10. In person tours will be held during Aug.-Oct.
